Good Evening Eagle Families,

I am writing to share some information regarding eLearning and school attendance which will begin tomorrow, 3/30/20 for all BHS students.

Students will be able to see their assignments for each class starting Monday 3/30 using Edsby which can be accessed from a smart phone or computer. Each teacher will post directions for class assignments. Students should use Edsby to email teachers with questions.

Brandon High School has distributed all of the laptops we had on campus. We will update you as more laptops become available. If you have not yet completed the BHS Technology Survey to tell us you need a device, please find that survey on Edsby at the top of the home page.

School attendance will be taken starting tomorrow. Students must check in on the Edsby page of their 1st Period Teacher by 3 p.m. every school day. Each 1st period teacher has set up an area for students to "check in" so they can be marked present. When students do not "check in" every day, BHS will send an automated call to parents each afternoon to let you know.

Students who do not have a 1st period class, should "check in" on Ms. Sparano's Edsby homepage each school day.

Students must complete their eLearning assignments to earn grades and credit for 4th quarter. 4th quarter grades will count toward student GPA's.

If your student encounters any difficulty with eLearning, they should contact their teacher. If this does not help, please contact your student's AP for Student Affairs.
